SETTING:

Here. Today. Everywhere. Forever.

CAST OF CHARACTERS:

He – Take him as you will. He's a boy, by the way. Any race/ethnicity.

She – Take her as you will. She's a girl, by the way. Any race/ethnicity.

He's Thoughts – Take them as you will. He's probably a boy, by the way. Any race/ethnicity.

She's Thoughts – Take them as you will. She's probably a girl by the way. Any race/ethnicity.

PLAYWRIGHT'S NOTE:

There are places in the script where few words occupy entire pages. That was on purpose.

If you need to re-type the script in any way for production purposes, please keep to the format in terms of punctuation, spacing between stage directions and lines, or placement of ellipses. I want the director, actors and designers to interpret the script as it is presented on the pages here.

Some sections requires characters to overlap their dialogue. I've designated when they start the next line with a "/".

Don't go overboard with set pieces. You can probably do this with 4 chairs and a small table. Allow the audience to use their imagination. What's important is the relationship between He and She and the struggles they have with their feelings for one another. Scene shifts should be short, sweet and indicated with a brief, consistent sound. A ding perhaps? A bell maybe? Something like that.

Finally, this is a play. Play. Have fun.

RUNNING TIME: Approx. 30 Minutes

HE So you do run out of energy. **SHE** Contrary to popular belief – yes. HE I had my doubts. HE and SHE share a nice laugh. As the laughter dies down – SHE smiles at HE HE smiles at SHE. Silence.

That day, right before I called you, I got a call. From my ex-boyfriend. I hadn't heard from him in, I don't know how long but he called and he said to me –

I've been thinking about you.
Just like that...
I've been thinking about you.
He said he wanted to see me.
...

When we were still together he went on a trip.

For –

Business.

A few weeks later, the day before he was supposed to come back, I got a phone call from him. He told me not to pick him up at the airport. He met a woman on the trip. Also from around here. He said he couldn't explain it but he was in love with her. In love with her in a way he couldn't be in love with me. The person he had been with for –

He left me for her. And now they are married.

He told me, back then – come on, you had to know there was no real future for us.

Now he's calling me telling me he's thinking about me. That he wants to see me.
